


Setting up Polls

The Polls section of event setup allows you to configure polls and questions you intend to ask the audience.

New event polls

You should have completed your initial event setup and you will see the below screen. This screen is the Events Dashboard for your new event. From this screen, click on the Polls option on the left hand side.



Setting Up Polls
